VANCOUVER, BRITISH COLUMBIA

After the National Convention at the Sheraton Guildford in Surrey, BC, board your luxury coach to the beautiful Canada Place Pier in Vancouver where you'll embark on your home for the week, the spectacular, Celebrity Eclipse

INSIDE PASSAGE, ALASKA (SCENIC CRUISING)

ICY STRAIT, ALASKA

Surrounded by towering rainforest, Icy Strait Point is a destination that offers unparalleled access to adventure, wilderness, wildlife, and genuine Native Tlingit hospitality. Icy Strait Point features 20+ exciting tours, a restored 1912 Alaska salmon cannery and museum, nature trails, restaurants, 100% Alaskan-owned retail shops, and even a beach! HUBBARD GLACIER, ALASKA (SCENIC CRUISING)

Hubbard Glacier is the largest calving glacier on the North American continent. The glacier routinely calves off icebergs as high as 10-story buildings, sending massive blocks of ice into the sea every few minutes.

JUNEAU, ALASKA

Juneau, Alaska's remote capital, sits in the state's panhandle, at the base of 3,819-ft. Mount Roberts. A tram carries visitors 1,800 feet up Mount Roberts to an alpine area with hiking trails, wildflowers and views of Gastineau Channel. Uncovering authentic local finds and having experiences that make you feel like you've really connected with a place are important elements in ensuring an extraordinary vacation.

KETCHIKAN, ALASKA

Ketchikan is an Alaskan city facing the Inside Passage, a popular cruise route along the state's southeastern coast. It's known for its many Native American totem poles, on display throughout town. Nearby Misty Fiords National Monument is a glacier-carved wilderness featuring snowcapped mountains, waterfalls and salmon spawning streams. It's also home to rich wildlife including black bears, wolves and bald eagles.

INSIDE PASSAGE, ALASKA (SCENIC CRUISING)

You'll never forget the sight of 40-ton whales hurling themselves into the air, almost completely escaping the water. If you're especially lucky, you could see them swimming together to create a bubble net, trapping and eating fish by the giant mouthful.
